*I am responsible for my own choices & behavior. If I am acting in a way that is not in alignment with spirit, I understand that I may be sent home at the expense of myself and my parent/guardian & that I may be unable to return or attend future events. These agreements apply to ensure the safety of each individual's spirit, mind and body.*

***I have free choice to attend events. I will make good choices and do my best to help create a safe and respectful space. I agree to follow the 5 finger / blast off rules:***

1. SAFETY:
  - I will control my body and my actions. I will help to make sure that my body and others are kept to ourselves and only use appropriate and safe touch that is respectful to each individual, allowing everyone to feel comfortable and remain focused on the event. This includes no rough playing.
  - I will help to keep the space clean and free from clutter.
  - I will stay with my leader at all times.
2. RESPECT:
  - I will pay attention to the adults and leaders around me, doing what they ask and listening when they are speaking.
  - I will ask, with a loving voice if I do not understand what is asked of me.
  - I will honor the three C's (no criticizing, complaining or comparing) This includes only using put ups - NO putdowns or insults of person or groups or ideas that others might have.
  - I will treat the facility and space around me with respect keeping it clean.
  - I will not touch any equipment being used at the event and ask permission before using anything that does not belong to me.
3. COMMITMENT:
  - I understand that to get the full benefit of any event I must be fully present when showing up by being well rested and having a good breakfast.
  - By showing up each day I make a commitment to FULLY participate in activities and group events. If I prefer to not attend I will share this with my parents so they may make other arrangements for me.
  - I agree not to bring a walkman, radios, cell phones, hand held video games, other electronic devices or any toys or trinkets to this event.
4. HELP OUT THE LITTLE GUY:
  - I understand that one of our beliefs at Unity is that we are all connected with others and that it is important to help out others.
  - I will do my best to help others around me. If they seek help and I am unable to help them I will ask an adult or leader to help them.
5. POSITIVE ATTITUDE:
  - I will extend courtesy and gratitude to the staff and leaders
  - I recognize that we are all here to have fun and that in the event that my team 'loses' a game or event I will practice being happy for the other team and focus on fun.
  - I will come from a loving space, keeping in mind that our thoughts create our world.

By deciding to attend, I understand these agreements, and I am willing to enter into them. The staff/leaders reserve the right to dismiss a person from this event, if it is felt that the person's conduct had been detrimental to the spirit of this event. In the unlikely event that this should become necessary, the minister and/or parent or guardian will be contacted and transportation home will be the expense and the responsibility of the parent(s).
